

# Estate Sale Authorization Form

1. Your Estate sale is not authorized until this form is returned to you signed by the Association and the date is placed on the Association's calendar.
2. This form must be received in time to return your authorization to you two (2) weeks prior to the Estate Sale.
3. Upon completing this form, it must be returned signed by the person authorized to conduct the Estate Sale with documentation naming said person as authorized to conduct such business.

**Upon receiving approval from the Association, the following rules must be adhered to:**

1. At the Discretion of the Association, a one (1) day estate sale may be held with the following stipulations:
  - Resident must register with the Association office no later than two (2) weeks prior to the day of the estate sale
  - The estate sale must be held within the confines of the residence and garage. No items can be displayed in the yard or driveway
  - The resident may utilize no more than two (2) signs; one at the closest major street
